The theme for the 8th EPH Conference is *Health in Europe – from global to local policies, methods and practices*. This theme was chosen to encourage discussion on what the role of Europe is at global level and what the impact of global health issues is on European, national, regional and local level. In times of interdependence and interconnectedness at global level, a new vision of cooperative and democratic action at all levels of society is much needed. Through the plenary sessions, this new vision is further elaborated.

DATE AND VENUE

The 8th EPH Conference will be held from 14 to 17 October 2015 at the new Milano Congressi (MiCo), Milan, Italy. This Exhibition Center and Trade Fair complex right in the centre of Milan, is one of the largest and most modern venues in Europe.

LANGUAGE

The conference language will be English.

PLENARY SESSIONS

The five plenary sessions are organised on the following themes:

- 'Global public health: what is expected from Europe?', organised by the initiator of the conference EUPHA (European Public Health Association).
- 'Healthy people, healthy planet', organised by EuroHealthNet.
- 'Cross border health threats and health care', organised by the European Commission.
- 'Learning from each other, best practices at local level', organised by the European Observatory on Health Systems and Policies.
- 'The global public health professional', organised by ASPHER (Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region).

The EPH Conference aims to contribute to the improvement of public health in Europe by offering the means to exchange information and a platform for debate to researchers, policymakers, practitioners, young professionals and students in the field of public health, health services research and public health training and education. The conference has a global dimension, with participants from over 50 countries. It covers a broad range of health issues, has a high political relevance, a large involvement of European networks and organisations and attracts a major audience of public health professionals.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The parallel programme reflects on a wide array of public health issues and ways of solving these issues at global, European, national, regional and local level. The parallel programme is set up with single abstracts (oral, pitch, poster presentations) and workshops. Detailed instructions can be found as of 15 January on www.ephconference.eu.

CONFERENCE FEES

Registration is possible for the full conference and pre-conferences. Daily registration is also an option.
